CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Construction on the new **Pershing Bikeway** has begun. It is expected to take two years to complete and will be a nice connection between downtown and North

Park.

Highlights:

- one travel lane in each direction.
- two-way cycle track on east side with very few crossing-conflict points
- for fast and confident cyclists there will be a buffered bike lane, or sharrows where narrow, on the southbound/downhill side.
- separate pedestrian facility with little reason for walkers to be on bikeway.
- well designed roundabout
- nice landscaping
