Beginning Sunday April 24 8:30 am

- Goal: Camaraderie, discovery and variety on bike.
- When: Sunday mornings at 8:30.
- Meet up & Route: the first few rides we'll meet at UCC. After that we will vary the route and our meet up location.
- Changes: The route and the meet up location may change from week-toweek. Check the Weekly Update for each week's meet up location and route.
- Distance/Elevation/Pace: 35-55 miles / 1,500' 4,000' of elevation gain / pace D-1/D-2 (14-17 mph). There will be regrouping as is normal on the 'D' rides.
- Experience required: We're riding in a variety of locations within San Diego. You must be able to find your way back to the start if you get dropped.

- Rules: Helmets required; Standard bike bottles only; No earbuds; No headphones; No cellphone use; No aero bar use; No flashing lights; and No e-bikes.


