SDBC Sunday Rides Are Back!

- When: Sunday mornings at 8:30
- Goal: Camaraderie, discovery and variety on bike.
- Meet up & Route: the first few rides we'll meet at UCC. After that we will vary the route and our meet up location. Check the *Weekly Update* for each week's meet up location and route.

Race Report Berkeley Hills Road Race, Orinda CA - 4/23/2022

Founded in 1957, Berkeley Hills Road Race is the oldest continuously-running bicycle road race in the US.

52 miles with 4,800' of climbing.

3 laps of the "Three Bears Loop". Baby Bear, Mama Bear and Papa Bear are the three major climbs with the finish at the summit of the last climb (Papa Bear).
45 riders started. 50+ and 60+ raced together, scored separately.
Weather: 60+ degrees, sunny with a light wind.

The majority of the peloton stayed together through the first half of the race. The split occurred on the descent before the final climb on the second lap and I was on the wrong side of it. Four of us formed a chase group. We could see the lead group up ahead but when the moto informed us the gap was approaching one minute, the other three stopped rotating seemingly deciding to conserve their energy for the finishing climb. They were unwilling or unable to take pulls in an attempt to catch the lead group of 12-15 riders. As long as there was a chance to catch them, I (foolishly) pulled the group all the way around the rest of the final lap. If nothing else, it was a good test of my fitness and satisfying to still finish ahead of them. My top speed was 47 MPH and I was still dropped on the descent.
