SDBC Red, White & Brew 2022

The previously posted routes have been revised to stay away from Torrey Pines Beach, using Carmel Valley Rd. and Sorrento Valley Rd. instead which also provides a more direct route from UCSD back to the park.

The longer route features steeper climbs with a trip up to Del Mar Mesa, the 56 bike path east to Camino Del Sur, and a descent of the Three Witches. The shorter ride follows the longer route at the beginning in the Miramar area, then takes the D-4 route back. Riders should be ready to roll at 9:00.


From the Secretary




