

Race Report

Cycle to the Sun - Sat 6/25/2022 Paia to Haleakala Volcano summit - Maui, Hawaii



35+ miles, 10,023' of climbing.

Mass start. 150 riders, 23 of whom were in my 60+ category. No distinction was made between categories during the race. Course is 99% steady climbing.

10 of us pulled away soon after the start which included 2 others in the 60+ category. I managed to stay with this lead group for the first hour until I was unceremoniously spit out the back. Ugh. Riding solo, for the next 1+ hour I was able to hold 10th place overall. However, approaching the last of the 3 feed zones at 8,000' elevation, I was no longer able to respond as riders passed by me. I managed to continue pushing through the final 2,000' of climbing to the summit and finished 21st overall and 5th place in the 60+ category.

After the race, I learned that the regular riders meticulously shave weight off their bikes so I decided to weigh my rental bike. It weighed about 5 pounds more than my competitors' ...


