

Dear Cycling Friends;

We have lost another SDBC Life Member from the peleton; Hannah North 67, passed away last week from brain cancer;

Hannah grew up in La Jolla, CA. and started riding with the San Diego American Youth Hostels in junior high school. In high school, she began training and racing with the San Diego Bicycle Club. Hannah became one of the top women's racer's in the USA! She won many State Titles and competed Internationally including the Worlds; Hannah was the winner of the first Women's Red Zinger Classic in 1975 and the only woman to race all Red Zinger and Coors Classics!

Hannah worked for La Jolla Cyclery, Skid-Lid Helmets, and Hewlett Packard in San Diego; In the late 80's she transferred to HP in Boise Idaho and started living the Mountain Life; Hiking, Skiing, Rock Climbing, Camping and traveling from Alaska to South America and every Mountain in between! During these adventures she met her husband, Tom Harper, retired from HP and built a beautiful home on 40 acers in Almo Idaho pop.100; They were setup forever!

But cancer would not stop and after years of breast, lung and brain cancer she's gone! Hannah North will be remembered as a "True American Women's Sportster!" Sincerely, Ralph Elliott, SDBC Historian, Life long Friend!


