

It's time for California to join many other states and the NHTSA and recognize the value of stop-as-yield for bikes. It's safe. It's smart. It's common sense. Many states, including most in the Western US, have adopted some form of the Bicycle Safety Stop, allowing people on bikes to treat stop signs as yields. Yet, despite support from advocates and the legislature, the Safety Stop has so far failed to become law in California.
