12.7 miles, 4,100' of climbing

The iconic climb of Mt Baldy starts at San Antonio Park, heads up Mountain Ave for 3 miles, a right turn on Mt Baldy Rd up to Baldy Village and then multiple switchbacks to the finish at the ski summit. Fairly steep climbing with some flat and downhill sections.

Since the race was a Time Trial format, riders went off in 30 second intervals. The bad news was I was passed by a few riders. The good news is I knew two of them were 55+ racers from LA. and when I looked at the others passing me, I figured their combined age would not add up to my 65+ category. Although my finishing time was not what I had hoped for, I did take my age category with 10 minutes to spare.

Mt Washington Hill Climb

Gorhan, NH Sat 8/19/2023

Race Cancelled

7.6 miles, 4,700' of climbing, 12% average grade.

At the start line, race morning was rainy, 50+ degrees (1,600' elevation). 10 minutes before the first wave was scheduled to start, the race was canceled. The observatory at the summit (6,288' elevation) was reporting steady rain, sustained winds of 45 mph with gusts up to 60 mph and a wind chill of 26 degrees. Sunday was the "weather day" if Saturday was canceled. On Sunday at the summit, winds were even stronger at a sustained 70+ mph with gusts over 80 mph so the race was once again canceled. Although disappointed to miss out on defending last year's first place finish, the right decision was made.

Now if those winds were a tailwind all the way up, a golden opportunity for a PR was missed. Does the UCI allow a sail on a race bike?


